# Fez City Tour (2 DAYS/1 NIGHT):

## Day 1 (Marrakech - Fes)

In the morning, drive crossing the Atlas mountains starts with an alternation of landscapes; limestones, cascades, volcanic peaks, huge and darks cedar forests, green oak trees. Arriving to Beni Mellal, which is at 625 m altitude at the heart of the Atlas, an agricultural market and commercial center reveals itself. Beni Mellal is also a small town special for the olive grove belt surrounding it. Lunch at Tazekount Hotel then continue to Fes Via Ifrane: a wonderful ski resort Dinner and Overnight at Hotel.

## Day 2 (Fes - Casablanca - Marrakech)

Cradle of thousand years of monarchy, Fes contains memories of 12 centuries of history and expresses the refined Hispano-Moorish culture. It is the spiritual and cultural Moroccan traditional center. Fes is a multifarious city; unique by its splendor. Fes is a network of winding alleys that can hardly be unraveled. Movement, noise, shouting, smell of tanned leather, delicate aroma of oriental perfumes, barbecues, sweet pastry all this is the imperial city. And few steps further from the Nejjarine fountain you can detect a cedar smell from the carpenters district. The alleys are also lined with places of study or prayers just like the

## TERRES D'AMANAR



## EXCURSION TO ESSAOUIRA

The town of Essaouira stands on a peninsula that is permanently swept by the trade winds. The best way to see Essaouira, the blue and white town, is on foot. Inside the 18th century fortified city walls, interesting architectural features include gates and windows with intricately carved decoration. The port of Essaouira is situated at the foot of the town's walls and at the end of a beautiful long sandy beach. With its gaily painted fishing boats and brightly coloured nets piled up on the quayside, it is a bustling and attractive place.



## WEEK-END IN OUARZAZATE



# IMPERIAL CITIES TOUR

## Day 1: Marrakech – Fez

Full day trip through the forests of Middle Atlas. We go first to Beni-Mellal, then to the sources of Ain Asserdoune, before we take the road of cedars. We will surely meet macaques, which inhabit the forests, and you can enjoy the many breathtaking views of the valleys.

## Day 2: Fez

**Full day for a complete tour of Fez:** Fez contains the memory of 12 centuries of history and reveals the extreme refinement of the Moorish culture. Spiritual & cultural centre of traditional Morocco: Fez is a city of diversity, unique in its splendour. The Medina narrow streets are animated by many souks, such as the tanners', dyers', or, the carpenters' which is just steps from the Nejjarine fountain. The streets are also marked by places of study or prayer such as the Zaouia of Moulay Idriss which considered one of the most blessed zaouias of Morocco. After lunch in an old palace of the Medina, the tour continues through the picturesque streets of Mellah, former Jewish area, around the Royal Palace and ends in beauty at sunset by enjoying the spectacular view that is offered throughout the city by the north fortifications.

## Day 3: Fes - Meknes – Rabat

After breakfast, the morning will be spent in visiting the Roman site of Volubilis, the ancient capital of Mauritania Tangitane. In the afternoon we visit the Medina of Meknes, with its walls that represent huge doors, probably the largest in Morocco. It shelters the splendid mausoleum of Moulay Ismail, the water house (Dar-el-Ma), the stables of Moulay Ismail (Heri es-Souani) and the huge Agdal pond. We reach Rabat where we visit the Kasbah of Oudayas, its white and blue houses, its narrow sinuous streets.

## Day 4: Rabat – Casablanca

After having admired the Medina huge front doors, we spend some time in the Andalusians' garden. The tour continues to the Hassan Tower and Mohammed V mausoleum, and ends with the necropolis of Chellal and its large gardens. Continue towards Casablanca

# KASBAHS AND OASISES

## Day 1: Marrakech - Ouarzazate

To reach Ouarzazate, we have to cross the High Atlas via Tichka (2260 m) through one of the most sinuous and beautiful roads of Morocco, where it is said, to live successively the four seasons. Visit of the Kasbah of Taourirt, former residence of Glaoui, last seignior of Atlas. Lunch in Ouarzazate. On the way, photo stop at the feet of the most beautiful of southern Morocco ksours. Restored by UNESCO and classified as World Heritage, Ait Ben Haddou looks like a medieval village of red earth that would have gone through time.

## Day 2: Ouarzazate - Tinghir - Ouarzazate

Departure for Tinghir across the road of thousands of Kasbahs, the beautiful Dades Valley and Kelâa des M'Gouna known for its annual festival of roses. We arrive in Tinghir. It is a famous oasis with palm grove and many ksours and Kasbahs. This is one of the finest and largest in Morocco, once a military post where they make silver Berber jewellery. We continue towards the Gorges du Todra, impressive red walls carved by nature. Lunch is optional. Free time and return to Ouarzazate.

## Day 3: Ouarzazate - Zagora - Ouarzazate

You will cross a beautiful rocky landscape, black and bright boulders of rocks and vertiginous cliffs before beginning an impressive descent into the valley of Draa. Not far from Jebel Zagora, you can see the village of red earth, Tamgroute, ancient religious centre, which houses in the library of its Zaouia the oldest and most precious manuscripts. This visit is an opportunity to appreciate the green pottery work of the region. Return to Ouarzazate.
